

How to get to Glen Gardens

Glen Gardens is on East parade in Heworth. There are entrances to the park from east Parade, Glen Road and Sixth Avenue. You may park either in the car park on East Parade (small charge) or there is free parking on Main Ave, Sixth Ave and other the residential streets this side of the park. The community garden is in the children's play area behind the hill with the slide. Glen Gardens is near to the Sustrans cycle path, route 66. Bus routes from Clifton and city centre use the purple line No 6 or Coastliner from Stonebow.
